PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING AND PUBLIC ON CACTUS STATE UTILITY OPERATING COMPANY, LLC'S APPLICATION TO PROVIDE WASTEWATER UTILITY SERVICES TO THE COPPER RIDGE SUBDIVISION IN THE TOWN OF WELLTON, IN YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA. (DOCKET NO. WS-21155A-22-0198)

Summary

On July 14, 2022, Cactus State Utility Operating Company, LLC ("Cactus State" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an extension of its existing wastewater Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide wastewater utility services to the Copper Ridge subdivision, located south of Los Angeles Avenue (Old US Highway 80) and east of Dome Street in the Town of Wellton, in Yuma County, Arizona.

THE COMMISSION IS NOT BOUND BY THE PROPOSALS OF CACTUS STATE, STAFF, OR ANY INTERVENORS. THE COMMISSION WILL DETERMINE THE APPROPRIATE RELIEF TO BE GRANTED IN RESPONSE TO CACTUS STATE'S APPLICATION BASED ON THE EVIDENCE PRESENTED IN THIS MATTER.
