 Lead & Copper Monitoring Violation January - June 2024

ARROWHEAD WATER SYSTEM PWS ID TX2470025 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we are doing (or did) to correct these situations.

*We must monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants regularly. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the 1st 6M2024 (January – June 2024), we did not monitor or test for lead and copper and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.*

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for [these contaminants], how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which the follow-up samples were [or will be] taken.

**What is being done?**

CSWR-Texas has recently transitioned to a new operating company to ensure timely monitoring of your drinking water. As part of this transition, we will be taking the required samples by September 30, 2024, and will continue to conduct these samples every six months to ensure ongoing compliance and water quality.
