

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER Shady Oaks (TX2470017), Wilson County, TX Chemical Monitoring, Routine Major

The SHADY OAKS WATER water system PWS ID TX2470017 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to collect and submit chemical samples of water provided to their customers, and report the results of those samples to the TCEQ on a regular basis.

We failed to monitor and/or report the following constituents: 1,2-DIBROMO-3-CHLOROPROPANE and ETHYLENE DIBROMIDE.

These violations occurred in the monitoring periods: 01/01/2022 to 12/31/2024

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from chemical contamination. We did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for chemical constituents, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

## What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You may continue to drink the water. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, we are required to notify you within 24 hours.

## What is being done?

CSWR – Texas is actively working to ensure all required sampling is completed and reported in full compliance with TCEQ regulations. We remain committed to maintaining timely monitoring and clear, proactive communication moving forward.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
