

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER Tall Pines (TX1010220), Harris County, TX Chemical Monitoring, Routine Major Violation for Radionuclides, 01/01/2018 to 12/31/2023

The **Tall Pines** water system **PWS ID TX1010220** has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to collect and submit chemical samples of water provided to their customers, and report the results of those samples to the TCEQ on a regular basis.

We failed to monitor and/or report the following constituents: Radionuclides

These violation(s) occurred in the monitoring periods: 01/01/2018 to 12/31/2023.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from chemical contamination. We did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for chemical constituents, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

## We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

CSWR – Texas Utility Operating Company has collected and submitted make-up samples for the missed monitoring periods, and all results were found to be within acceptable limits.
