

## Lawn Watering Program

CSWR-Florida UOC promotes a rotating schedule for lawn watering, to promote the reduction in outdoor water usage. Details of the plan are outlined below:

### 1. Lawn Watering Days & Times:

- a. Lawn watering should be limited to no more than twice per week.
- b. Irrigation is prohibited between 10am and 4pm.
- c. Irrigation is allowed for one hour per zone.
- d. Lawn Watering days and times should be as follows unless the county has a different schedule or stricter hours in effect.
  - i. During Daylight saving time (second Monday in March until the first Sunday in November).
    1. Homes with odd numbered addresses or no addresses should water on Wednesday and Saturday before 10am or after 4pm.
    2. Homes with even numbered addresses should water on Thursdays and Sundays before 10am or after 4pm.
  - ii. Eastern Standard Time (First Sunday in November until the second Sunday in March).
    1. Homes with odd numbered addresses should water on Saturdays before 10am or after 4pm.
    2. Homes with even numbered addresses should water on Sundays before 10am or after 4pm.
  - iii. Hand watering and micro-irrigation of plants (other than lawns) may be done on any day and any time.
  - iv. New Lawn and Plants
    1. New lawns and plants have a 30-30 establishment period.
    2. On the day of installation, watering should be done at the time of installation. Additional watering should be done on an as needed basis.
    3. During the initial 30 days, watering should be done three days a week, on any day, before 10am and after 4pm. Watering should be completed in accordance with the referenced schedule with one additional day of watering if needed.
