**Council Creek Village (TX0270014), Burnet County, TX**

Maximum Contaminant Level Violation, Gross Alpha, Excluding Radon and Uranium Q1 (Jan-Mar) 2025 and Q3 (July-Sept) 2025

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has notified the COUNCIL CREEK VILLAGE TX0270014 that the drinking water being supplied to customers had exceeded the Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) for gross alpha excluding radon and uranium. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has established the MCL for gross alpha excluding radon and uranium to be 15 pico curies per liter (pCi/L) based on running annual average (RAA), and has determined that it is a health concern at levels above the MCL. Analysis of drinking water in your community for gross alpha excluding radon and uranium indicates a compliance value in quarter one of 2025 of 124 pCi/L and in quarter three 2025 of 91 pCi/L for EP001.

This is not an emergency. Certain minerals are radioactive and may emit a form of radiation known as alpha radiation. Some people who drink water containing alpha emitters in excess of the MCL over many years may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

You do not need to use an alternative water supply. However, if you have health concerns, you may want to talk to your doctor to get more information about how this may affect you.

We are actively exploring solutions to address the current water supply challenges, considering options such as implementing advanced treatment or developing a new water source. We are working closely with Texas Commission of Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to monitor the situation and integrate solutions as soon as possible. Maximum Contaminant Level Violation, Combined Radium Q1 (Jan-Mar) 2025 and Q3 (July-Sept) 2025

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has notified the COUNCIL CREEK VILLAGE TX0270014 that the drinking water being supplied to customers had exceeded the Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) for combined radium (-226 & -228). The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has established the MCL for combined radium (-226 & -228) to be 5 pico curies per liter (pCi/l) based on running annual average (RAA), and has determined that it is a health concern at levels above the MCL. Analysis of drinking water in your community for combined radium (-226 & -228) indicates a compliance value in quarter one 2025 of 39 pCi/l and a compliance value in quarter three 2025 of 30 pCi/l for EP001.

This is not an emergency. However, some people who drink water containing radium 226 and/or 228 in excess of the MCL over many years may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

You do not need to use an alternative water supply. However, if you have health concerns, you may want to talk to your doctor to get more information about how this may affect you.

**Council Creek Village (TX0270014), Burnet County, TX**

Council Creek Village has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we are doing (or did) to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During June 1 – Nov 30, 2025 we did not monitor or test – or – did not complete all monitoring or testing for lead and copper water quality parameter testing and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for [these contaminants], how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which the follow-up samples were [or will be] taken.

**We are taking the following actions to address this issue:**

CSWR–Texas is ensuring that all required samples for Council Creek Village are collected in accordance with TCEQ sampling requirements and within the correct monitoring period. The required water quality parameter samples were to be collected between June 1, 2025, and November 30, 2025; however, they were collected outside of the required time frame on December 26, 2025, and December 31, 2025.

Please share this information with all other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
