



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER Vineyard Ridge Water Supply (TX0860144), Gillespie County, TX Monitoring and Reporting Violation, Q4 (Oct – Dec) 2024

The VINEYARD RIDGE WATER SUPPLY water system PWS ID TX0860144 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to collect and submit chemical samples of water provided to their customers, and report the results of those samples to the TCEQ on a regular basis.

We failed to monitor and/or report the following constituents: Nitrate.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period of Q4 (Oct – Dec) 2024.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from chemical contamination. We did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for chemical constituents, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

CSWR – Texas is ensuring that all required samples for Vineyard Ridge Water Supply are collected in accordance with TCEQ sampling requirements. A Nitrate sample was collected on March 13, 2025 to resolve this violation. Additional Nitrate samples were collected on June 12, 2025, October 22, 2025, and February 10, 2026.
