



## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER Hickory Hill (TX2470018), Wilson County, TX CHEMICAL MONITORING, ROUTINE MAJOR**

The **Hickory Hill** water system **PWS ID TX2470018** has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to collect and submit chemical samples of water provided to their customers and report the results of those samples to the TCEQ on a regular basis.

We failed to monitor and/or report the following constituents EDB/DBCP (Ethylene Dibromide / Dibromochloropropane) Synthetic Organic Chemicals

This/These violation(s) occurred in the monitoring periods: **Jan 2022 – Dec 2024.**

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from chemical contamination. We did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for chemical constituents, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

### **We are taking the following actions to address this issue:**

We failed to collect the required monitoring samples for Ethylene Dibromide (EDB) and Dibromochloropropane (DBCP) during the compliance period from 2022 through 2024. Because the required monitoring was not conducted, the system could not verify compliance with drinking water standards for these contaminants during that period.

Upon discovery of the missed monitoring requirement, the water system immediately coordinated sampling and collected the required EDB and DBCP samples in December 2024. Laboratory analysis confirmed that both contaminants were below their respective Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCLs). The water system has reviewed its compliance monitoring schedule and implemented additional tracking procedures to ensure all future monitoring requirements are completed and reported on time.
