

**NOTICE OF CSWR-FLORIDA UTILITY OPERATING COMPANY'S PETITION TO
ESTABLISH RATE BASE VALUE USING ALTERNATIVE PROCEDURE**

Notice is hereby given that CSWR-Florida Utility Operating Company, LLC ("CSWR-Florida") has filed a Petition with the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") to establish the rate base value of the Forest Utilities wastewater system using the alternative procedure set forth in Section 367.0811, Florida Statutes and Rule 25-30.0372, Florida Administrative Code. The Petition was filed with the Commission on May 27, 2026 and assigned Commission docket number 20260083-SU. A copy of the Petition is available on the Commission's website at <https://www.psc.state.fl.us/dockets>.

As required by Section 367.0811 and Rule 25-30.0372, CSWR-Florida's alternative valuation petition includes a five-year projection of the rate impact. In its next rate case, CSWR-Florida expects to consolidate its rates over all Florida customers. If the Commission grants the full alternative valuation petition requested by CSWR-Florida, the five-year projected consolidated rate impact attributable to the requested alternative valuation is \$2.33 per residential wastewater customer, per month. If consolidation is not granted and the alternative valuation is factored into customer rates in a subsequent rate case, then the five-year projected impact of the requested alternative valuation is projected to be approximately \$6.85 per residential wastewater customer, per month. Any change to rates, if approved by the Commission, would occur only in a future rate proceeding.
