



At White Hills Units 3, 4, & 6 providing safe drinking water is our highest priority. Regulations require us to notify you when test results show that a water quality standard has been exceeded.

White Hills 3, 4, and 6 Water AZ0408039 Did Not Meet Monitoring Requirements

Our water system violated drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations. We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During July – Sept 2025 we did not complete all monitoring or testing for contaminants in your water and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminants we did not properly test for during the last year; how often we are supposed to sample and how many samples we are supposed to take; how many samples we took; when samples should have been taken; and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.

Contaminant	Required sampling frequency	Number of samples taken	When samples should have been taken	When samples were next taken
Disinfection Byproducts	1 Sample/Year	0	July – Sept 2025	Due Aug 2026

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

The missed monitoring has been identified, and additional tracking measures have been implemented to help ensure future samples are collected on time.
