



At Council Creek Village, your health and safety are our highest priorities. From time to time, regulations require us to share public notices if certain monitoring, testing, or reporting steps are not fully completed.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

COUNCIL CREEK VILLAGE TX0270014, has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we are doing (or did) to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During **June – Nov 2025**, and **Jan – June 2026** we did not monitor or test - or - did not complete all monitoring or testing for **lead and copper water quality parameter tests** and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for lead and copper water quality parameter tests, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which the follow-up samples were or will be taken.

What is being done?

The required monitoring has been scheduled and/or completed, and we are working to ensure all future lead and copper water quality parameter monitoring is completed within the required monitoring periods. We will continue to monitor in accordance with TCEQ requirements.
